






OCATION, SETTING, AND LIVING ENVIRONMENT.
























TYTHAT IS THE RIVER DANCE?

TITLE AT THE RIVER DAMCE.

Ownership of condominium residences at The River Dance is FREEHOLD. In British Columbia, freehold condominiums involves absolute ownership of the lot (as "freehold" or a "fee simple" estate). Common areas, that is areas within the property intended for the use and enjoyment of all lot owners, are owned collectively by the tenants in common. Finally, balconies, terraces, and parking stalls will be assigned to individual lots as Limited Common Property in the manner set out in the Disclosure Statement.

LIMITED COMMON PROPERTY.

Limited Common Property is a designation of space that provides for the exclusive use of the area in question to the designated lot owner. Individual owners are responsible for the maintenance of their Limited Common Property. Finally, balconies, terraces, and parking stalls will be assigned to individual lots as Limited Common Property in the manner set out in the Disclosure Statement.

DOES THE RIVER DANCE HAVE NEW HOME WARRANTY?

Absolutely! Great West Development Group is a member of the New Home Warranty Program of B.C. and the Yukon. The condominium residences at THE RIVER DANCE will be covered by a third party New Home Warranty.

Maintenance fees paid by the owners are the source of funds necessary to operate the building on a day to day basis. The total annual budget is then divided by 12 to yield the buildings operating costs on a monthly basis. Finally, this monthly amount is then pro-rated to individual lots on the basis of their "Unit Entitlement". This latter term is a measure of each lot's proportionate share for the entire building's "Habitable" (or livable) area. This means that homes within The River Dance that have the same square footage will have the same maintenance fees, regardless of whether they are located on the second floor or the tenth floor.



In the case of River Dance, his latest twin tower project near the Fraser River on South East Ma-rine Drive, he had 60 garden plots for owners incorporated into the landscaping plan adjacent to the building. They aren't very big, just 4 ½-by-8 feet, but they have been tremendously popular with buyers, so much so that Lepur is seeing if the city will allow him to put more on the other side of the

property. Fifty per cent of the 105 suites in the first tower sold in three weeks and for several buyers having the use of a garden plot was conditional to the sale. The was conditional to the sale. The community gardens will have benches nearby and Lepur says it should provide a meeting place where owners can get to know their neighbours. Buyers receive a \$200 gift certificate for Dig This garden shop and the store will give new residents another 20 per cent discount.

Revitalization of the industrial lands along the north banks of the Fraser River is winding down and Lepur says currently he is the only developer with new highrise homes in the popular area.

Just a block down Jellicoe Street is city parkland and the river walkway where pedestrians can stroll the riverbank watching the boat traffic and water birds. On the River Dance site city planners requested two highrises overlooking the river surrounded by a lot of landscaped area, and Rositch Hemphill Architects have complied with these specifications. They have also taken full advantage of the view potential.

The two 12-storey buildings are angled so that all but one suite on each floor above the second have river views. And the north facing exceptions are compensated by and overview of the Fraser Golf Course and North Shore moun-

Architect Keith Hemphill says it's a more expensive upgrade to standard building practice but it has a better ability to prevent water egress. Architecturally, it gives a cleaner look to the building too and allows more glazing, Hemphill says.


Lepur who has been developing projects since the early '80s, doesn't go in for volume. He has been doing one project a year for the last decade, and the River Dance is his most ambitious to date.

"I really try to identify the local market and cater to it," he says. That means no splashy ad campaigns or glossy brochures. He prefers to pass the savings on to the buyers. "The consumer gets quality rather than razzle dazzle," he says.

The sales centre, in an old warehouse, is low budget too. The Dig This people have constructed a little garden plot display and a scale model of the buildings is centred in the room. A model kitchen and bathroom may seem a little lost in the vast area, but on close inspection, they adequately tell the story. Above the sample corner fireplace is a television with a virtual realty video showing all angles of the buildings, superimposed on shots of the actual site with river backdrop.

Of the floor plans that line the walls, several have already sold out. They range in size from 487 to 897 square feet and are priced from \$89,900 to \$279,900. In the one-bedroom suites, a fireplace is an optional upgrade, because, Lepur says, buyers have said they prefer the extra wall space. He also listened to people who said they prefer rectangular or square rooms for ease of furnishing. so you'll find no curves or crazy angles.

Since several shoppers in this first phase have requested three-bedroom suites, the architects may be revising plans for the second tower. The sales centre is open daily from 1 to 6 p.m.


