Historic Murrayville

Long admired for its picturesque surroundings and vibrant community spirit, Murrayville is an officially recognized heritage site brimming with character and charm. The second oldest community in Langley, it originated in the mid-1870s when its founder and namesake, Paul Murray, along with his three sons, staked the land at each corner of the New Westminster-Yale Road-Fort Langley Trail intersection. As more homesteaders followed, "Murray's (Five) Corners" blossomed into a thriving hub of activity complete with a hotel, blacksmith, butcher, bowling alley, tea room and post office. At the centre of it all was Porter's General Store where, today, you can still pick up delicious fresh-baked pies, dime-store candy and local artisan delights — only now you'll also find free Wi-Fi access and the best chai tea lattes in town.

The Winchester community was named in honour of William and Ann Winchester who, in 1915, arrived in Murrayville to begin a bright, new future. Along with their daughters, Elizabeth and Ann, the Winchesters devoted much of their time to the local church, where they helped build the deep-rooted sense of community that still exists today.

A new home in an established neighbourhood — that's what ParkLane Homes is offering buyers at Winchester in Langley.

The 141-townhome community in “the heart of Murrayville” is being built in two phases.

The first 23 homes go on sale today and will be ready for occupancy in July.

“Murrayville isn't an area that sees a lot of development,” says ParkLane marketing manager Yosh Kasahara. “It has lots of tradition, lots of history.” Six of the eight houses built in Murrayville's first subdivision in 1910 still stand.

Named for the Murray family, which settled there in 1874, Murrayville is located roughly between 216 and 224 Streets on either side of Fraser Highway. It is the civic core of Langley Township, site of the municipal offices, W.C. Blair Recreation Centre, Langley hospital and Langley Regional Airport.

But the traditional heart of the neighbourhood is Porter's, established as a general store in 1888, owned by the Porter family from 1916 to 2009 and now a bistro serving organic fair-trade coffee, breakfast, lunch and dinner, along with dime-store candy, homemade pies and local artisan foods.

The interior retains the store's original fixtures, floors, cabinetry and 1911 cash register, while outside hangs a vintage general store sign advertising the Star Weekly, a Sunday magazine supplement delivered with newspapers from 1910 to 1973.

It is an easy walk from Winchester to Porter's, the recreation centre and Langley Fundamental Elementary. Ralph's Farm Market and Murrayville Square, which includes an IGA Marketplace, Shoppers Drug Mart, A&W and other conveniences, are just up the hill, while Willowbrook Mall and downtown Langley are a five-minute drive away.

“We are being told by the people who are visiting us that they've been waiting for this community for a long time,” Kasahara says. “A lot of people are just jumping at the opportunity to get into this area because not a lot of homes become available here and there aren't a lot of town houses in this area.”

He recently began booking appointments to preview the homes, with the more than 1,000 people registered with the Winchester website. Most of the prospective buyers are local residents, equally divided between first-time buyers and single-family homeowners looking to downsize.

The two fully furnished show homes were each decorated with one of these scenarios in mind. The first, imagined for a mature couple who like to travel, entertain frequently and have a teenage son who plays guitar, is the Campbell floor plan with the living room at the front, the dining area in the middle and the kitchen at the back with a deck off it. The décor is traditional, yet stylish, with chinoiserie wallpaper in the dining room and gold (the new silver) accents throughout. The kitchen has Winchester's upgrade package of white-painted Shaker-style maple cabinets, stainless steel appliances, built-in microwave, tiled backsplash and cultured stone counters. The breakfast bar and pantry cupboards are standard Campbell features. Upstairs, one of the three bedrooms has been furnished as an office with a window seat. The Campbell master suite has a walk-through closet to the ensuite bath with walk-in shower and double sinks.

The second show home, designed for a design-conscious younger couple with two small children, is the Belmont floor plan with the living room at the front, galley-style kitchen with a long breakfast bar in the centre and a large dining room at the back with sliding doors to the deck and enough space for a built-in desk. Because Belmont homes are end units, there are windows on the side, as well as at the front and back. Furnishings are modern and low-profile in trendy greys, blues and greens. This show home kitchen has standard Winchester black appliances, flat-front cabinets and laminate countertops. Upstairs, custom decorator features include a "family tree" motif on the wall of the hallway, a height chart painted on the wall of the kids' bathroom and a slim walnut wall unit that holds a flat-screen TV while concealing wires and a DVD player in the master bedroom.

There are four floor plans available in the first release. The Belmont, Campbell and Murray homes all have three bedrooms, two baths and two-car tandem garages. Fraser series homes will have an extra bedroom and bathroom in the basement and a double garage. All homes have private entrances, open-plan main floors with nine-foot ceilings, laminate flooring, tile flooring and accents in ensuites, linen cupboards and upstairs laundries. Some have walkout basements, walkout patios and tiled entries. Outdoor spaces vary: some homes have front yards with back decks, while others have private fenced backyards. Optional upgrades in addition to the ones in the Campbell show home include a washer/dryer, electric fireplace with cultured stone surround and finished security system.

A dilemma many interior designers face when decorating show homes is twofold: How to make the home stand out from the rest, yet how to make it appealing to a good cross section of buyers.

Interior designers Cynthia Florano of ParkLane Homes, along with Sarah Brown of Sarah Brown and Company, think they found the right combination at ParkLane's Winchester community in Langley.

"Really, the starting point for any show homes is to pull from the current trends," Florano says. "Many buyers are inspired by what they see in home magazines, so our homes have to be current and fresh, without being too trendy to the point where homeowners can't relate to the decorating."

It's a balancing act, both agree.

For example, in unit 12, the duo incorporated a work station next to the dining room and added bold graphic wallpaper, clean lines, fresh colour and then took it a step further by adding a lower desk unit for the child.

"When we furnished this home, we pictured a young family in their thirties with a young child," says Florano. "So adding the child's desk allows the child to work alongside mom."

Each show home is distinct, adds Brown, with the two designers trying to appeal to specific target markets.


Unit 11 was designed for buyers in their forties who are established in their careers and enjoy entertaining family, often hosting dinner parties on the weekends.

The designers reflect that idea of sophistication with high-end finishes throughout — in the stainless steel appliances and the larger, more expensive barbecue on the patio.

"The living and dining room also

bring a higher end residential feel with luxurious fabric textures, wall coverings and a chandelier that completes the room," adds Florano.

When it comes to colour, blue is the market leader for 2011.

"For our traditional unit 11, we used a vibrant shade of blue with a warm nude tone and paired bold stripes and solids to capture this developing trend," both say.

Another trend right now, says Br
