Great schools such as Abbotsford Senior Secondary and University of the Fraser Valley surround you at The News.



The News stands on the site of the historic Abbotsford News, one of BC's earliest community papers, founded in 1906 by pioneering publisher John A. Bates.


































DESIRABLE ABBOTSFORD






HOLD THE PRESSES
